- Promote both group and individual cultural diversity, as a result of an exposure to different approaches and ways of interpreting and experiencing each and every facet of Argentinean Tango.

- Argentinean Tango and styles
- Argentinean Tango and health
- Argentinean Tango and theoretical-methodological proposals
- Argentinean Tango and instruction
- Argentinean Tango and cultural industries

The deadline for the presentation of dissertations on Argentinean Tango that do not fall under any of these categories will be June 14th, 2013.

GUIDELINES FOR THE PRESENTATION OF PAPERS

Academic and research papers



- 1. The papers must be unpublished, written in Spanish of English.
- 2. No more than 2 (two) papers per author.
- 3. Papers on preliminary, exploratory or ongoing research will be admitted.
- 4. The papers (including notes and bibliography) will be no more than 15 (fifteen) pages long. Specifics:
 - Paper: A4
 - Font: Arial, 12 pt
 - Paragraph spacing: 1.5 pt
 - Margins: 1.2 in
 - Microsoft Word format
 - Notes: placed in the footer and consecutively numbered.
 - CD and paper copies required.
- 5. In order to establish publishing criteria, please respect the following quotation format:
 - <u>In the text</u>: (Last name of author Year: page)
 - <u>At the end of the text, as bibliography</u>: LAST NAME, Name, Year Title in italics. Place of publication: Publisher.
 - In the case of articles, as bibliography: LAST NAME, Name, Year Title in italics. In: Name of publication, volume: number of pages comprised in article. Place of publication: Publisher.
 - In the case of chapters in a book: LAST NAME, Name, Year Title in italics. In: Name of compiler, Name of the book in italics, volume: number of pages comprised in chapter. Place of publication: Publisher.
- 6. An abstract of no more than 200 (two hundred) words will be included in the registration form. The form must be emailed to folklore.congresotango@iuna.edu.ar before July 12th, 2013. Please, indicate in which category the paper is to be included.
- 7. The dissertations will last no more than 20 (twenty) minutes per paper.
- 8. A Referee Council will assess the papers for publication.



Artistic Productions

The papers presented under the category "Argentinean Tango and Artistic Production", in addition to the previously described requirements, must include a DVD of the complete production, uncut, filmed on wide angle and with a fixed camera.

The fees include participation in the three-day Conference and the workshops offered at the end of each day.
